

Scholarship Program

Eligibility:

To be eligible to apply for an Amarillo Community Federal Credit Union Scholarship, the following criteria must be met:

- o Current Amarillo Community FCU member
- o A graduating high school senior (in 2018) or a current college student
- Applicant must have a GPA of 3.0 or greater
- Applicant must provide verification of acceptance or enrollment in an accredited college, university or technical school.
- Applicant must be a U.S. Citizen

Application Requirements:

Completed and signed application form Official copy of transcripts provided for review

- Two (2) letter of reference/recommendation:
 - 1. One from a high school or college instructor:
 - 2. One from someone not related to the applicant
- Typed essay (300 words or less) describing the applicant's:
 - i. Education goals
 - ii. Personal goals and expectations
 - iii. Credit unions care. How are you going to give back to your community, in the spirit of the credit union philosophy of "people helping people", as a result of your college education?

Application Procedure and Deadlines

Applications, transcripts, and other related materials must be postmarked no later than Saturday, March 31, 2018. Applications received late, incomplete or not in accordance with the guidelines will be ineligible. Scholarship recipients will be notified by April 30, 2018.

Disbursement of Scholarship Funds:

Funds will be disbursed by check made payable to both the Scholarship recipient and the accredited school.

Scholarship recipient agrees to appear in person at a predetermined time and place to receive their scholarship.
