



Lehigh Valley Educators Credit Union Scholarship Program



The Awards

Ten \$1,000 scholarship certificates will be awarded at the LVECU Annual Meeting in March 2019 (date TBA).

Eligibility

Applicants must:

- be a member of LVECU in good standing for 12 months (custodial accounts and joint owners do not qualify)
- be enrolled **full-time** for the upcoming semester as a student of an undergraduate program, or a minimum two-year course of study at a community college, trade school, or technical school
- 2018 winners not eligible for 2019 scholarships

Employees of LVECU, board members, volunteers, and their immediate family members are not eligible.

Application Process

2. All applications must be submitted and postmarked by January 31, 2019. No late submissions will be accepted.

Selection Process

The scholarship winners will be selected by the LVECU Scholarship Committee. The committee will consist of board members and staff members. Winners will be notified by the end of February and will be invited to the LVECU Annual Meeting to accept their award. **Scholarship money will be deposited into the winners' savings account following the completion of the fall 2019 semester and submission of grades, provided they meet the required 2.75 GPA.**

The applications will be judged on the following:

Essay	50%
Academic Merit (Minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.75)	25%
Extracurricular Activities/Community Service	<u>25%</u>
Total	100%

5. _____ Proof of full-time enrollment: a copy of your bill, a letter of acceptance, or a course schedule. If not available at time of application, recipients may submit by 5/31/19.
