The rate will be 4.0% for each loan type. The amount you borrow is up to you. You must qualify and it has to be paid back in one year.

January 1st to June 30th

There will be a discount of Half percent (1/2%) across the board. This includes new and used. Recreational vehicles will be discounted at three percent (3%).

Don't forget, we also can refinance your current car loan from another institution.
